How to book your X-ray appointment

About this resource

Use this process if your doctor or other health provider has told you that you need an x-ray (except chest x-ray). It will allow you to book your x-ray at the time and place that works best for you.

How do I book my appointment?

- If you need a **chest x-ray**, there is no need to book: please go to any of the x-ray departments listed below, and they will be able to take your x-ray (no appointment needed).

- For **all other x-rays**, please scan this QR code:

- You will be sent an email or text reminder the day before your appointment.
